COVID-19 OVERVIEW AND HEALTH PROTOCOL ADVICE

Abstract

Viral diseases continue to emerge posing a serious public health issue (WHO). There has been Epidemic cases with unexplained LRTI in the last 20 years. Some initially classified as "pneumonia of unknown etiology." The etiology of this illness was attributed to a novel virus belonging to the coronavirus (CoV) family. In January 30, 2020 the outbreak was declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) as it had spread to 18 countries with four countries reporting human-to-human transmission. The government of Kenya saw it important to sensitize the non-healthcare staff through a training, hence the genesis of this paper. Health protocol advise for COVID-19 is " Avoid touching MEN (Mouth Eyes and Nose), instead follow WOMEN (Wash your hands/sanitize, Obey social distance, Mask up correctly, Exercice and Eat well, No unnecessary crowding). Non- compliance of this advice is punishable by court of law of Kenya.
