Factors affecting adoption of organic Practices by small farmer in Mahasarkham, Thailand Orawan srisompun

Abstract:

The Thai government has a policy to promote jasmine rice production in an organic system, but the adoption of an organic approach remains at low levels. This study aimed to analyze factors that influence the adoption of organic rice cultivation by farmers in Maha Sarakham province, Thailand, by using the concept of sustainable living together with a logistic regression model. Purposive sampling was used to recruit a sample group of farmers from 160 households that were cultivating organic and conventional rice in Maha Sarakham
