All the manuscripts are subjected to vigorous peer-review process to ensure quality and originality. Total of 45 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, 50% articles were by foreign authors.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Thomas Ryzlewicz, during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Cernaro Valeria in bringing out issues of JNT in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of JNT, the office bearers and staff of IPA secretariat for their support in bringing out yet another volume of JNT and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume of JNT in scheduled time.

Two very distinguished scholars whose role particularly have been seminal in promoting Journal of Nephrology and Transplantation in developing and emerging economics namely Prof Thomas Ryzlewicz and Prof. Cernaro Valeria are joining as Editorial Advisor of this journal. I am sure with their guidance; we will be able to make this journal more relevant to the research community.
