

Metastatic colorectal cancer

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Abstract

1) The Rationale

Women with colon cancer range of psychological, social as well as medical difficulties. However, social support, especially from a spouse, has been shown to have a protective function during this time. This study examined the ways that women's daily mood, pain, fatigue, and marital satisfaction predict women's report of partner support in the context of colon cancer, (Metastatic colon).

Approximately 50% of people with colorectal cancer (CRC) develop metastatic disease, meaning the cancer becomes advanced because it spreads from the colon to other places in the body, often to the liver or brain.

2) The Method

Preliminary data from a study and the effects of women's daily mood, colon cancer, pain and fatigue on higher levels of mood, pain and fatigue. On a woman's report on the social support she received from her partner, as well as how the effect of mood interacts with the marital satisfaction of both partners

3) The Results

The results show that on days when women reported higher levels of pain, fatigue, and negative or positive moods, as well as on days when they reported more pain and fatigue, they reported higher average levels of fatigue but not pain with higher support. Finally, women whose husbands reported higher levels of marital satisfaction reported receiving more partner support, but marital husband satisfaction did not

mitigate the effect of women's mood on support.

4) The Conclusion / Implications

Colon cancer is a common malignancy that causes a significant number of deaths. However, it is potentially preventable through screening and highly curable with surgery alone when diagnosed at an early stage. Modern chemotherapy continues to improve survival for patients with more advanced stages
