In 2013 there were over 42 million health workers, according to WHO among them were 9.7 million doctors, 19.7 million nurses and midwives – just under half the total workforce – and 12.6 million health workers from other professions or with some level of training. WHO estimates health care is already a \$7.2 trillion a year industry, equivalent to 10.6% of global domestic product. On current trends the number of nurses and midwives in Africa will grow from 1.0 million to 1.5 million between 2013 and 2030, but the shortfall in the number required to meet the need will grow from 1.8 million today, to 2.8 million by 2030.
