A total of 24 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 3 articles published in volume 8. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 26 Editors, 10 Reviewers joined the board of OHDM and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.
